



cuddle fleece
crib skirt

free tutorial



Materials and supplies:

1 Cuddle Kit (20 squares of cuddle fabric, 10"x10") available [here](#)
1.5 yards cotton fabric
coordinating polyester thread
yard stick or quilting ruler
fabric marker or chalk

Cutting list:

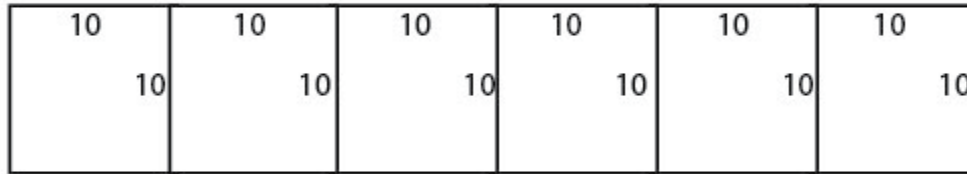
from the Cuddle Kit:
Take 4 squares and cut them down to 7" by 10". Choose 10 remaining squares. You will have 6 squares left over.

from the cotton fabric:
29" x 53" for the crib skirt

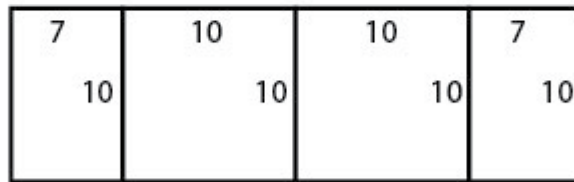
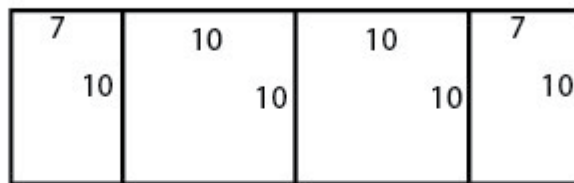
Crib Skirt

1/2 seam allowances included

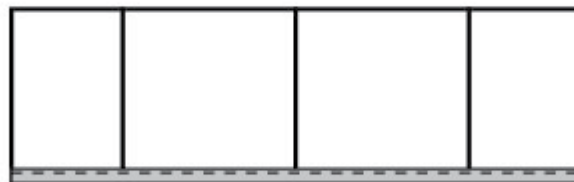
1. Sew 6 cuddle squares together to form the front of the crib skirt.



2. To form each of the two end panels, sew 2 cuddle squares together. On each end, sew a 7" x 10" piece.

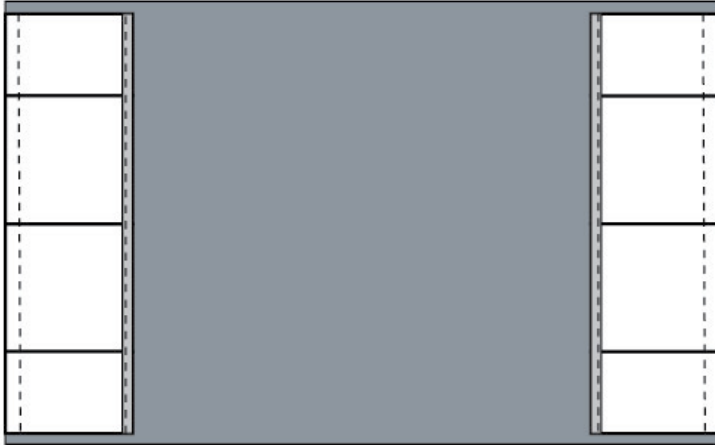


3. Fold under bottom edge of each long panel to wrong side by 1/2" and sew hem into place.

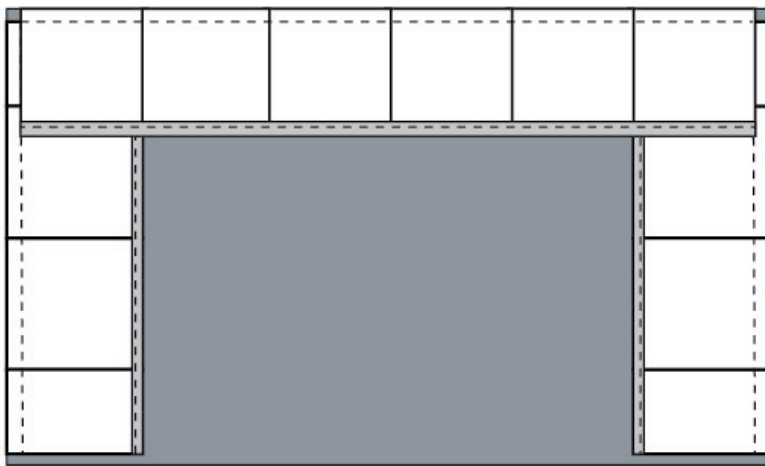


4. On each end of all 3 rows, fold the short end to the wrong side by 1 1/2" and stitch hem into place.

5. Sew top end end of each end panel to rectangle cut out of the cotton fabric, beginning 1/2" from each corner.



Repeat with longer panel



6. Finish remaining edge of cotton fabric with a zigzag or serger, and fold over the edge to the wrong side by 1/2" and stitch hem into place.
